



Regulations of the Dukla Wolf Race 2021 stage race

1. Purpose of the competition

Popularization of mountain biking and bicycle tourism in Poland and Slovakia.

- 1.1. Promotion of regional, supra-regional and international tourist routes and destinations.
- 1.2. Selecting the best competitors in the international, stage MTB marathon held in Poland and Slovakia.
- 1.3. Promoting a healthy lifestyle, active rest and recreation.

5. Conditions of participation

The participant of the Dukla Wolf Race will be a person who meets the following conditions:

By filling in the application form (in electronic or written form), the participant accepts the following clauses:

a. By signing up to participate in the competition, the participant accepts the rules of the event and agrees to the free use of his image recorded in the form of a photo or video, and grants the Organizer a free license to use it in all fields of use, including: recording and disseminating in any form and entering into the computer memory, used for the promotion and conduct of the Organizer's events, sharing with sponsors and partners of the events in order to promote them in the context of participation in the event, posting and publishing in the Organizer's publications, on promotional printed materials of the Organizer, in the press, on websites and in messages television and radio. If you do not agree to share your image in the above-mentioned places, the Organizer should be informed about it in writing (I do not consent to the publication of my image recorded during my participation in the Dukla Wolf Race in public space). By accepting the regulations and joining the competition, the participant also agrees to the processing of his personal data for the purposes related to the organization and promotion of events and acknowledges that he has the right to access and correct his data, these data will be kept in a safe place, they will not be sold to third parties or any organizations. By entering the event, the competitor declares that he / she agrees to provide first aid, perform other medical procedures and transport the injured to a safe place, to medical and paramedical personnel acting on behalf of the organizer. The participant acknowledges that participation in a sports event involves physical effort and entails a natural risk of accident, personal injury and physical injury (including death), as well as property damage and loss. In addition, participation in the competition may involve other risk factors that are not foreseeable at the moment. Signing the declaration of knowledge of the regulations means that the Participant has considered and assessed the scope and nature of the risk related to participation in the event, he starts voluntarily and solely at his own risk.

☒ 5.1. Make the entry fee within the time limit provided for in the regulations (preferred fees via internet banks). The original proof of the entry fee (in justified cases) should be kept for inspection at the Competition Office.

☒ 5.2. The right to start in the Dukla Wolf Race is open to people over 18 years of age.

☒ 5.3 .. Each participant is required to wear a hard helmet.

Category K2 - women aged 18 to 30 (born 1991 - 2003)

Category K3 - women from 31 to 40 years (born 1981 - 90)

Category K4 - women from 41 years (born 1980 and older)

Man (2 men)

Mix (1 male, 1 female)

7. Fees

From 01/12/2020 - - to 31/05/2021 - PLN 300

from 01/06/2021 - until 16/07/2021 - PLN 400

on the day of the competition (competition office) - 600 PLN

When signing up for the Dukla Wolf Race, a link to convenient online payments will be sent to the e-mail address provided during registration.

8. Rules for running the race

The Dukla Wolf Race stage race will be held in accordance with these regulations.

The competition will be run with a minimum of 80 paid competitors.

In all disputes, not included in the regulations, the Jury Committee will decide in agreement with the Organizer of the Dukla Wolf Race.

Individual competitors and teams have the right to start in the competition. The team consists of 2 people who will be classified in the MAN (only men) and MIX (at least 1 woman) category.

The entry limit is 250 competitors (applies to a stage race)

The winners in individual age categories and in the Open category in the General Classification will be the competitors and teams who will complete the route of 3 stages of the Dukla Wolf Race in the shortest total time.

The first three cyclists on the podium in each age category will be decorated after the first (August 27, 2021), second (August 28, 2021) and third (August 29, 2021) stages.

Lack of or damage to the bib number preventing its reading by the judges will be punished.

Only mountain bikes in good technical condition will be allowed to start the race.

The participant is responsible for the condition of the bike during the race.

During the competition, the Dukla Wolf Race doctor reserves the right to withdraw a participant who is not physically fit to continue the race.

The start of the first stage will take place at 10.00, to the second stage at 9.00 a.m. The start of the third stage will take place at 9.00 am.

The starting line will remain open for 15 minutes. from the starting signal. Riders who start later will not be included in the stage results and will not qualify as runners.

At the start of stage 1, the competitors will start from the joint start.

For stages 2 - 3, the competitors will be seeded according to their places in the Open classification after stage 1.

»1 sector: places 1 - 30, additionally leaders of individual categories

»2nd sector: places 31 - 60,

»3rd sector: places above 61.

The starting sectors will be open: before the first stage from 9.45am, before leg two from 8.45am, before leg three from 8.45am

In special cases, the Organizer reserves the right to individually position a competitor in a given sector (based on the declared sports level or results obtained in other races). Entry limit to the finish line of the stages: the first stage at 4:00 p.m., the second and third stage at 5.00 p.m.

Riders outside the time limit may continue the race, but will not be included in the classification. In exceptional situations, the Organizer allows the possibility of classifying a competitor who did not meet the time limit after submitting an appropriate application.

The top three cyclists on the podium in the age category must be present at the decorations after each stage. Time penalties will be assigned for the absence from the podium: the first absence is 3

minutes, each subsequent absence 5 minutes. The decoration of the winners after the end of the first stage will take place at 15.00, stage two and three at 5.00 p.m.

The route will be marked and permanently secured by judges and paramedics.

There will be checkpoints on the route. Omitting min. one checkpoint will be penalized with disqualification.

There will be food points on the route of the Dukla Wolf Race stages.

Any possible repairs of the equipment and other situations requiring the competitors to stop must take place within the visibility of the trail in a way that does not hinder other competitors from riding.

9. Classification

The winner of the general classification will be the competitor who will cover the route of 3 stages of the Dukla Wolf Race in the shortest total time. In case of obtaining the same total time by two or more competitors, the winner in the general classification will be determined by the higher place obtained in the last stage, after which the general classification will be announced. After each stage, a leader will be selected, ie the competitor leading in the general classification. In the event that two or more competitors achieve the same total time, the competitor with the higher position in the last classified stage becomes the leader.

The Team classification is a classification based on the individual results of the Women's Open and Men's Open of each stage of the Dukla Wolf Race.

Time to team classification is calculated according to the general classification scheme.

10. Awards

At each stage, the three best competitors in each age category will be awarded with sports trophies or material prizes. The top three teams will be awarded with sports trophies.

In the general classification of the Dukla Wolf Race, the three best competitors in each age category and the three best teams will be awarded sports trophies, prizes in kind or in cash.

All awarded competitors and teams are required to participate in the decoration ceremony at the end of each stage and during the final decoration ceremony.

11. Penalties

The Jury Committee, in agreement with the Organizer, may adjudicate the following penalties:

1. A warning.
2. Time penalty
3. Disqualification.

The team or competitor may be punished by the Organizer in particular for:

- »Not using stiff helmets,
- »Excessive littering (outside the special zone, which covers 200 m behind each regeneration buffet),
- »Disregard for the natural environment,
- »Deficiencies in the equipment, affecting driving safety,
- »Non-compliance with the rules of fair play,
- »Unsportsmanlike behavior,
- »Pushing or pulling the rider by third parties,
- »Breaking the rules of the road,

In the event of disqualification, the organizer will not refund the entry fee.

12. Withdrawal of a competitor during the race

Competitors withdrawing from participation in the competition during the Dukla Wolf Race, regardless of the reason for the withdrawal, are obliged to immediately inform the organizer of this fact before the beginning or after the end of the stage.

If a competitor withdraws during the stage, this fact should be reported by calling the telephone number +48 570 293 946 in order to avoid the commencement of the rescue operation.

If as a result of not informing the organizer about the withdrawal from the race, search activities will be undertaken, all the costs of the rescue operation are covered by the wanted competitor.

In special cases, bearing in mind the welfare of the competitors, the Organizer, in consultation with the race doctor, has the right to withdraw the team from the competition.

13. Suggested equipment of the competitor

- »At least 2 liters of fluids,

- »Energy bars or gels,
- »Basic tools for repairing a bike,
- »Spare inner tube,
- »Pump.

14. Recommended equipment of the competitor

Dukla Wolf Race is a stage race in which participants follow a designated route. We recommend that each participant has a mileage counter, or a device with GPS navigation and a mobile phone.

15. Road traffic

The Dukla Wolf Race will take place in open road traffic.

Right-hand traffic is in force in Poland and the Slovak Republic. All competitors on dirt and public roads should move on the right side of the road and strictly obey the provisions of the Road Traffic.

Competitors must be particularly careful, bearing in mind the possibility of vehicles leaving fields, forest roads or individual buildings.

The organizer is not responsible for any collisions and accidents on the route.

16. Protests

Protests to the Chief Judge of the competition may be submitted in writing during the competition. The protest must be accompanied by a deposit of PLN 100. The deposit will not be returned unless the Main Judge, in agreement with the Organizer, agrees with the protesting party. The final decision belongs to the Chief Judge.

17. Additional information

The organizer is not responsible for random accidents occurring when participants travel to and from the competition.

Each participant takes part in the competition at his own risk.

The organizer is not financially responsible for items lost during the competition.

The organizer is not responsible for any collisions and accidents on the route.

Not knowing the regulations will not be considered an excuse.

People without starting numbers on the marathon routes will be removed from the route by the technical staff.

Each stage has steep climbs and dangerous descents.

The race will be held regardless of weather conditions.

The organizer reserves the right to cancel the event due to natural disasters or other disasters considered to be "force majeure".

All competitors are asked not to litter the marathon routes and to pay special attention to the natural environment.

In the event of resignation from participation in the event, the Organizer will not pay the entry fee.

The participant of the Dukla Wolf Race stage race, by filling in and signing the Application Form, accepts the terms of these Stage Race Regulations and agrees to the processing of his personal data.

The organizer and the Chief Judge reserve the right to interpret these regulations and to amend them.

18. Information clause

2. The Personal Data Inspector may be contacted in writing to the administrator's address and by e-mail: inspektorodo@onet.pl.

3. Your personal data is processed on the basis of the consent granted to the extent and for the purpose specified in the regulations, i.e. participation in the competition.

4. Your data may be made available in accordance with the regulations, including: the local press, local media on the Organiser's website, the Municipal Office in Dukla, the entity with which the contract for entrusting the processing of personal data - TIMEKEEPER Piotr Jemioło, 39-100 Ropczyce ul. Market 1.

5. We will not transfer your data outside the European Economic Area. We store the collected data until the purposes of processing described above are achieved, only in the case of image, we will store the data indefinitely or until the consent is withdrawn, because it results from the nature of processing, for example keeping a chronicle, albums. Your image may also be processed, made available in accordance with art. 81 sec. 2 of the Copyright and Related Rights Act (permission does not require the dissemination of the image of a person constituting only a detail of the whole such as an assembly, landscape, public event)

6. You have the right to access personal data, rectify, delete, limit processing and the right to withdraw consent. If you become aware of the unlawful processing of your personal data, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office in Warsaw. Providing your data is voluntary, but failure to provide data will prevent you from participating in the

competition. Lack of your consent to image processing will not have any consequences. The data under the consent will not be profiled and will not be processed in an automated manner.

COVID -19 Claims (see below)

The rules of safe implementation of the offer of the Municipal Sports and Recreation Center in Dukla during the COVID-19 epidemic in Poland:

1. Participants of sports events, competitions, sports sections, gyms and other events organized by MOSiR in Dukla, are obliged to:
 - a. hand disinfection at the entrance and exit from the MOSiR premises;
 - b. in the case of signing up for an organized event, party, etc. by MOSiR, resigning from participation in it in the event of disease symptoms that may indicate an infectious disease, including COVID-19 infection,
 - c. joining a given event, party, etc. only being a healthy person, not having contact with people in quarantine or with persons suspected of being infected with the COVID-19 virus,
 - d. keeping a 2-meter distance between participants of the event, event, etc.,
 - e. submit a declaration constituting Appendix 1 to these Regulations, if deemed necessary by the Director of MOSiR in Dukla. The Director of MOSiR in Dukla, depending on the type of the organized event, services of the Center, may decide that the declaration constituting Annex 1 is required or not from a specific group of participants.
2. Participation in a given event, etc., is tantamount to accepting these regulations, the provisions of which the participant is obliged to follow.
3. Information clause regarding the processing of personal data wz. from the COVID-19 epidemic in Poland.
 - a. The administrator of the processed personal data of event participants, etc. is the Municipal Sports and Recreation Center in Dukla, with its registered office at ul. Amii Krajowej 1A 38-450 Dukla, represented by the Director. Contact to the Administrator: phone no. 13 433 03 35, mosir@dukla.pl. Contact to the Data Protection Officer by email: inspektorodo@onet.pl.
 - b. Personal data will be processed in order to ensure safe and proper implementation of the sports and recreational offer by the Center during the COVID-19 epidemic in Poland, such as: participation in sports sections, events, sports competitions, organization of camps, holidays for children, access to gyms and other services offered by MOSiR in Dukla.
 - c. The basis for the processing of personal data is: - art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c GDPR, art. 9 sec. 2 lit. b GDPR, i.e. fulfillment of the legal obligations incumbent on the administrator specified in the following provisions: - the Act of March 2, 2020 on special solutions related to the prevention, counteraction and combating of COVID-19, other infectious diseases and crisis situations caused by them, - art. . 6 sec. 1 lit. b GDPR, i.e. taking up and performing a contract, - art. 9 sec. 2 letter i GDPR, i.e. processing is necessary for reasons related to the public interest in the field of public health, in particular when it is necessary for humanitarian purposes, including monitoring of epidemics and their spread, - art. 6 sec. 1 letter d of the GDPR, i.e. processing is necessary to protect the vital interests of the data

subject or another natural person. - Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. a GDPR, i.e. on the basis of previously granted consent in the scope and purpose specified in the consent.

d. Providing data processed on the basis of consent is voluntary, and you also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. If you wish to withdraw your consent, a written request should be submitted to the Director of MOSiR in Dukla. Withdrawal of the consent given does not affect the compliance of the processing which was carried out on the basis of the consent before its withdrawal.

e. Using the MOSiR offer in Dukla is voluntary, thus providing personal data is not a statutory obligation, however, if you do not provide data, it may result in the inability to use the MOSiR offer.

f. Recipients of personal data may be: public authorities and entities performing public tasks or acting on behalf of public authorities, to the extent and for the purposes that result from the provisions of generally applicable law. The recipient may be entities with whom a contract for entrusting the processing of personal data has been concluded. Details on recipients can be obtained from the administrator's premises. The recipient of the data may be the Poviats Sanitary and Epidemiological Station and the Chief Sanitary Inspectorate.

g. Data will not be transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area (ie third countries). The data will not be processed in an automated manner and will not be profiled.

h. Personal data will be kept for the period necessary to achieve the purpose set out above, and thereafter for the period required by the provisions of generally applicable law on archiving. Data on information obtained to protect against COVID19 infection, Annex 1, will be stored for a period of 14 days from collection, after which time will be permanently and safely destroyed.

i. The data subject has the following rights: the right to access personal data; the right to request rectification of personal data; the right to delete personal data - if the basis for their processing has ceased, consent has been withdrawn, personal data is processed unlawfully, personal data must be deleted in order to comply with the obligation resulting from legal provisions; the right to request the restriction of the processing of personal data - if: the data subject questions the correctness of the personal data, the processing of data is unlawful, and the data subject objects to the deletion of data, requesting their restriction instead, already needs the data for its purposes, but the data subject needs it to establish, defend or pursue claims. In the event of incorrect processing of personal data, you also have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection in Warsaw.
